

ESU 10 Request For Proposal

High Speed Connectivity to GNENC Backbone

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is in response to Educational Service Unit 10 (ESU 10) telecommunication and Internet access needs. It contains specific requirements to be met by the vendor's proposed solution. The objective of this request is to generate provider transport and Internet access service solutions for ESU 10 and member schools to access the Greater Nebraska Educational Network Consortium (GNENC) backbone and Network Nebraska's network and Internet Access.

This system will provide the ESU 10 school districts with the necessary connectivity to a GNENC aggregation point. See Appendices for a listing of schools and locations.

Time-scales for vendor selection are aggressive, with the implementation of services beginning on July 1, 2008 and completed no later than August 1, 2008.

Vendors have to respond to the following price component of this RFP:

- * Circuit Installation and Testing
- * Hardware Acquisition and Installation (if necessary)
- * Implementation of Services

The vendors are required to review this document and submit their response as per the schedule included in this document.

Confidentiality

This RFP, plus any other documents released, information provided, discussions, etc., as part of the selection process, are strictly confidential and should not be divulged to anyone who is not directly involved in preparation of the response. Additionally, all information within this proposal or gained during the RFP or other processes will remain confidential by the vendor. No information or publicity will be allowed to any third party unless specific written authorization is obtained from ESU 10.

It is a condition of this RFP that the information provided herein is for the purpose of allowing vendors to submit proposals to ESU 10. It may not be used in any other context nor revealed to any other party not directly involved in the submission of a proposal in accordance with the terms of the specification.

Proposal should be labeled "Proposal to ESU 10 for High Speed Connectivity to the GNENC Backbone".

ESU 10 reserves the right to accept or decline late proposals at its absolute discretion.

The proposal should include the name of the person to whom ESU 10 may address any questions relating to the proposal.

Respondents should provide three complete copies of the proposal. One electronic version of the proposal in PDF format is required, plus one electronic version of any cost worksheet in Microsoft Excel format.

Ron Cone should be contacted for supplementary information relating to this RFP via the above contact details. All requests should be written. E-mail is acceptable.

Preparation of Responses

The preparation and submission of the proposal shall be made without obligation to acquire any items included in the proposal, or to discuss the reason why the proposal is accepted or rejected. Any entity covered in this RFP requesting services will send notification of acceptance to the vendor.

The requirements specified in this RFP reflect those presently known. ESU 10 reserves the right to vary, in detail, the final requirements.

ESU 10 will not be responsible for or required to pay any expense incurred in the preparation or evaluation of any proposal.

ESU 10 may require that all or part of the successful proposal be included in the contracts.

All prices shall be consistently in US dollars and all unit prices, charges and totals must include all taxes and surcharges and exclude potential e-rate discounts.

General information, which is not specifically requested, should be attached separately and clearly labeled "Supporting Material".

Contract

This document does not constitute an offer to sell, or a solicitation of an offer to purchase.

ESU 10 reserves the right to accept or reject all or part of the proposal.

ESU 10 requires that contracts covering the provision of services and/or equipment requested in this RFP be negotiated to the satisfaction of ESU 10 and/or entity requesting the services.

This RFP covers multiple entities. Services requested by eligible entities included in the RFP shall be contracted and invoiced directly between the bidder and the entity requesting the service. ESU 10 does not intend to hold contracts for all services requested by this RFP.

All vendors are required to acknowledge that they agree to the conditions set out in this section.

Current System

Currently the GNENC consortium (comprised of ESUs 10, 11, 15, & 16) and member schools have assisted in deployment of a high speed data network for 83 school districts in Nebraska. This high speed network provides opportunities for high bandwidth applications and activities such as Internet access and Distance Learning. The GNENC also provides Domain Name Services (DNS), web content filtering, email, and other Internet related services.

The GNENC currently collects and maintains Internet access for 46,000+ students and 4,500+ educators in 83 school districts in the state of Nebraska. Various vendor networks converge into a backbone network at locations in North Platte, Kearney, and Grand Island. The Internet is used in virtually all classrooms served by the GNENC for e-mail, file transfer, and web browsing. The increased amount of streaming video provides course enrichment and knowledge enhancement. The Internet has become a tool in day-to-day business for administrators as well as educators and students. ESU 10 is an intermediate regional agency providing supplementary educational

services to the listed school districts in central and south-central Nebraska. ESU 10 is an active partner in this consortium and has 39 member schools receiving services through this consortium.

The intent of this RFP is to provide ESU 10 member schools high bandwidth connection options and Internet access to existing regional and statewide networks. Currently GNENC & ESU 10 purchases 50 MB of Internet Access on behalf of their member schools. Some schools desire the ability to purchase additional Internet bandwidth that can be prioritized or guaranteed to their network to improve performance during peak usage.

Proposals should be bid utilizing local, regional, or statewide telecommunications transport options currently in place or proposed in the sections of this RFP. Details of the existing network connections can be provided upon request (see Appendix D for locations). Internet access should be bid as an aggregated service at one of the GNENC or Network Nebraska backbone or Internet POP locations to enable the ability to continue offering centralized services provided by ESU 10, GNENC and/or Network Nebraska.

Vendors may respond to one or more sections and are encouraged to include pricing for all sites within each section.

Transport Service:

- **50 MB (minimum)** aggregated transport with ability to increase to 100 MB delivered to a ESU 10 network point (see **appendix D** for locations)
- Must be e-rate eligible
- Must be a full-duplex transport service
- 24/7 monitoring
- Maximum of 30-minute response time for trouble notification. Maximum 4 hours on-site response (if required).
- Guaranteed service level (guaranteed uptime). Monetary recourse for failure to comply.
- Engineering support via telephone.
- Multi-year contract featuring voluntary contract extensions.
- Zero downtime at cut over to new service.
- Able to implement new service beginning July 1, 2008.

- Sufficient aggregated transport to an ESU 10 network point with ability to increase bandwidth as appropriate to the network proposal. (see **appendix D** for locations)
- Must be e-rate eligible
- Must be a full-duplex transport service
- 24/7 monitoring
- Maximum of 30-minute response time for trouble notification. Maximum 4 hours on-site response (if required).
- Guaranteed service level (guaranteed uptime). Monetary recourse for failure to comply.
- Engineering support via telephone.
- Contract duration of no less than 12 months and no more than 48 months (contract extensions optional)
- Zero downtime at cut over to new service
- Able to implement new service beginning July 1, 2008.
- Ability to co-locate GNENC or ESU 10 equipment at vendor site. List of potential equipment is available from the ESU 10 contact listed on this RFP.
 - 24x7 access to co-located equipment at vendor site by ESU 10 technical contact or designee.

Section 4. School Internet Access through a regional or statewide network

Internet Service:

- Access costs provided in 1 MB to 3 MB increments up to 200 MB.
- Must be connected to the regional GNENC or statewide Network Nebraska networks
- Must be delivered over a full-duplex transport service
- Must include transport costs if aggregation location is not at an ESU 10 network point or within the Network Nebraska network.
- 24/7 monitoring
- Maximum of 30-minute response time for trouble notification. Maximum 4 hours on-site response (if required).
- Guaranteed service level (guaranteed uptime). Monetary recourse for failure to comply.
- Engineering support via telephone.
- Contract duration of no less than 12 months and no more than 48 months (contract extensions optional)
- Zero downtime at cut over to new service
- Able to implement new service beginning July 1, 2008.

Vendor Requirements

All vendors must give a comprehensive profile of their organization in the following format and order.

- Organization: 'Organization' concerns the structure and size of the company both in terms of its head office and other worldwide regional locations.
- Please provide information as to whether the organization is independent or part of a larger conglomerate. If the latter, please provide details on the holding company.
- Please provide corporate mission statement and strategic direction of the product. Also long term plan for addressing emerging technology
- Please provide information as to whether the organization is the ISP, reseller or value-added resellers (VARs). If the latter two, please also provide details of the company.
- Please provide information of any alliance or affiliation that with which the organization partners (e.g., equipment supplier, standard groups, industry groups).
- Please provide information of the organization statistics (e.g., geographic distribution, market share, reputation, company highlights, etc.).
- Please provide information of your organization's performance against others in the industry.
- Please provide information on how much the organization spent on research and development as a percentage of revenue for the last two years.

Location:

'Location' concerns the location and size of operations at the head office and any regional offices. For each location please state:

- Number of employees by function (technical and non-technical).
- Whether the offices are wholly owned subsidiaries of the main head office or if it is a third-party managed operation (VARs).
- Also indicate the office from where an implementation would be managed.

Experience

'Experience' concerns the relative experience vendor has in terms of an implementation of this size related to the business activity and distance from the most local regional office. Please provide information as to the experience of your consultants and retention rate of your key support people in the last two years.

Reference Sites:

'Reference sites' concerns the location and relative suitability of sites where the service is already implemented and is currently operational. Please provide:

- Number of reference sites by geographic area
- Other locations

For each reference sites, please provide the following:

- Client company name
- Client contact person
- Client address (street, city, country, post code), email address, telephone a fax number
- Client number of employee
- Client industry
- The service that was delivered
- The date of the delivery

For reference locations whose software applications most closely match ESU 10 requirements, please outline the business activities carried out at these sites and their use of your service. Please indicate the period of time each site has been in operation with the designated service.

Other Information

Please also provide us with any other information which you see as relevant, specifically any known weakness that the service has in terms of functionality or implementation/training requirements.

Maintenance and Support

Vendors are required to provide the following information related to the support and maintenance of the proposed solution.

- Options available for support, names and addresses of Agents (if any) in the region.
- Maintenance charges and the spectrum of activities covered under such maintenance contracts.
- Support availability (Help Desk, hotline, etc.) and duration for which they are available.
- Response time to support inquiries from ESU 10 and/or school technical contacts.
- Standard hours during which support will be provided and out of hours support options and costs.
- Uptime guarantees.
- Number of staff in the support team.
- Implications of modifications on upgrade, maintaining modification and potential costs.
